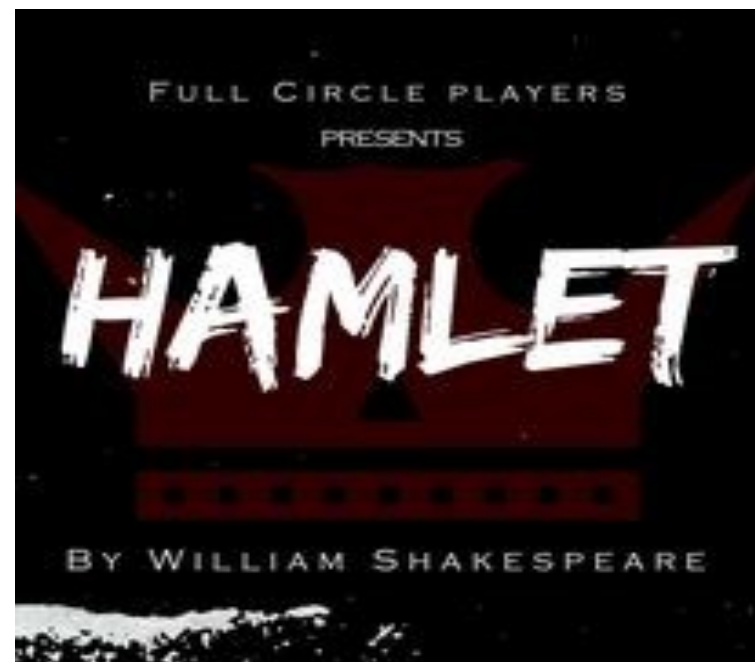

BRIEF SYNOPSIS

What is happening in Hamlet?

Things to know: Time is out of joint, meaning out of order. Something is rotten in the state of Denmark. This is a world filled with lies and betrayal. Everyone is lying, holding something back or betraying others. Hamlet is an Aristotelian Tragedy. Everyone has a secret.

1. Hamlet's father has died suddenly. Hamlet, Jared Sandoval, returns to Denmark to find his Uncle, Claudius, J. Kay Weldon, is now elected King and his mother, Gertrude, Rebecca Reber, has married him. While reflecting on grief, he is visited by the ghost of his father, Pierre van der Westhuizen, who tells him he was murdered and to get revenge for this murder.
2. Meanwhile Laertes, Jackson Nagata, prepares to leave for France, he and his sister Ophelia, Samantha Rose, talk about the rumor of Hamlet and she liking each other. Their father, Polonius, Jeremy Schaeg, gives Laertes advice on good living. Laertes departs. Leaving Ophelia with her father. Hamlet enters and tries to tell Ophelia how he feels, but is unable.
3. King Claudius and Gertrude, greet Hamlet; his childhood friends, Rosencrantz and Guildenstern, Romeo Maybrier and Jeremy Mercao, they ask the friend to help find out why Hamlet is upset. They agree. And go to visit Hamlet, who is suspicious.
4. A group of players come to town, Teri Pope, Matthew Johnson, Pierre van der Westhuizen, Hamlet asks them to add some lines to their play tonight. Then, alone he reflects on vengeance and his inability to do what his father asked him to do. He gives the players acting lessons and asks his good friend Horatio, Janette Valenzo, to watch the king and see what happens.
5. A play is performed, the king Claudius rises and runs off. Hamlet is happy, he got his confession.

ACT 2

1. Everybody is upset. Polonius and Gertrude plan to talk to Hamlet and get some answers. Hamlet enters, fights with his mom and kills Polonius, accidentally.
2. Claudius, afraid of what Hamlet may do, plots to send him to England and sends his friends Rosencrantz and Guildenstern with him. They do not return.
3. Ophelia, is turned desperate. Laertes comes home to avenge the death of his father, Polonius. He sees his sister Ophelia and is very upset. Claudius gets Laertes to agree to a plot against Hamlet.
4. Gertrude tells of the death of Ophelia. Hamlet returns home and with his friend Horatio meets with some Gravediggers. He discovers Ophelia is dead.
5. King Claudius sends Osric to ask Hamlet to duel Laertes, who demands satisfaction for the deaths of his family. Hamlet agrees. There is a fight. And then the play ends like a Shakespearean tragedy.
